GENERAL VOTING will be open to qualified electors of the City of Langford on Saturday, October 20, 2018 between the hours of 8:00 am and 8:00 pm at Millstream Elementary, 626 Hoylake Road, Langford, BC and Ruth King Elementary, 2764 Jacklin Road, Langford, BC.

ADVANCE VOTING opportunities will be available to qualified electors of the City of Langford on Wednesday, October 10 and Wednesday, October 17, 2018 from 8:00 am to 8:00 pm on both dates, at Langford Municipal Hall, 877 Goldstream Avenue, Langford, BC.

ADDITIONAL ADVANCE VOTING opportunities will be available to qualified electors of the City of Langford on Wednesday, October 17, 2018 at the following locations:

- Cherish at Central Park, 917 Avrill Road, Langford, BC between 8:00 am – 11:00 am
- Priory Hospital, 567 Goldstream Avenue, Langford BC between the hours of 12:00 pm – 2:00 pm
- Alexander Mackie Lodge, 753 Station Avenue, Langford, BC between the hours of 3:00 – 6:00 pm

Any qualified elector may vote at an Advance Voting opportunity.

CHANGE IN SPECIAL VOTING OPPORTUNITIES: Please note that the previously advertised special voting opportunities on general voting day have been cancelled and are now rescheduled as the above advance opportunities.

ELECTOR REGISTRATION

If you are not on the list of electors, you may register at the time of voting by completing the required application form available at the voting place. To register you must meet the following qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- Resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- Resident of OR registered owner of real property in the City of Langford for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- Not disqualified under the Local Government Act or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

To register, resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

To register, non-resident property electors must not be entitled to register as a resident elector and must produce **2 pieces of identification** to prove identity (at least one with a signature), **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property (e.g. a tax notice), and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of other property owners. Additionally, the following applies: *The only persons who are registered owners of the property, either as joint tenants or tenants in common, are individuals who are not holding the property in trust for a corporation or another trust.*

A person may only register as a non-resident property elector in relation to one parcel of real property in the City of Langford.

MAIL BALLOT VOTING

The City of Langford does not offer mail ballot voting.
