BUSINESS LICENCE REGULATION (COVID-19) BYLAW

Take notice that, in accordance with section 59(2) of the *Community Charter*, the City of Langford intends to consider the adoption of proposed Business Regulation (COVID-19) Bylaw for the purpose of regulating businesses that remain open during the COVID-19 pandemic. The proposed bylaw is intended to protect the health of business owners, employees, and customers, while preserving the ability of the public to shop for essential goods.
