



## Notice of Intention to Consider Issuance Temporary Use Permit

Council for the City of Langford hereby gives Notice of Intention to consider issuance of a Temporary Use Permit at its Regular Meeting scheduled for September 20, 2021, at 5:30 pm. **Public attendance is by electronic means and not in-person.**

Applicant	The Original Farm Langford Ltd.
Location	The lands that are the subject of the application are units 105 and 111, 945 Reunion Avenue (Belmont Market) as shown in shading on the included map.
Purpose	The purpose of the proposed Temporary Use Permit is to operate a non-medical cannabis retail store.
Proposal	To amend the original Temporary Use Permit to extend the operating hours to 9 am to 9 pm Sunday through Wednesday and 9 am to 10 pm Thursday through Saturday and to increase the number of signs from two to three for the existing non-medical cannabis retail store.
