Council for the City of Langford hereby gives Notice of Intention to consider issuance of a Development Variance Permit at its Regular Meeting scheduled for Monday, 20 September 2021, at 5:30 pm. **Public attendance is by electronic means and not in-person**.

Location	The lands that are the subject of the application are 918 and 924 Jenkins Avenue as shown in shading on the included map.
Purpose	The purpose of the proposed Development Variance Permit is to vary landscaping requirements for two 24-unit apartment buildings.
Proposal	 That Section 3.21.02(3) of Zoning Bylaw No. 300 be reduced to nil for the interior side lot line between 918 and 924 Jenkins Avenue to allow development without of installation of a fence and landscape screening between the two properties; That Section 3.21(02)(3) of Zoning Bylaw No. 300 be varied to reduce the required landscape planting area from 1 m to 0.35 m for the properties at 918 and 924 Jenkins, subject to the following condition: That a 1.8 m decorative fence be constructed;

The purpose of this Notice is to acquaint the property owners and residents in the area with the specifics of the proposed permit. Should you wish to make a submission to the Council in writing we require your name and civic address and that this be received, either electronically or by mail, no later than 3:00 PM on the date of the meeting as noted above so that your submission may be included in the Council's agenda package.
