

Construction Noise Outside of Permitted Hours

Effective May 16, 2022 the City of Langford enacted a new Noise Regulation Bylaw, restricting the hours during which construction and construction related noises are permitted, these provisions are set out below.

CONSTRUCTION / COMMERCIAL NOISE

6.1 The following activities may be performed during the times and days as stated below.

| <p>Construction – Exterior or where windows and doors are not fully installed:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Saturdays between the hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Sunday and Statutory Holidays Prohibited unless authorized by a Permit |
| <p>Site Preparation, Grading and Servicing work:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM Saturdays between the hours of 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM Sundays and Statutory Holidays - Prohibited unless authorized by a Permit |
| <p>Rock Breaking, Rock Drilling and Rock Crushing:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Saturdays, Sundays, and Statutory Holidays - Prohibited unless authorized by a Permit |
| <p>Blasting:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monday to Friday between the hours of 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM Saturdays, Sundays, and Statutory Holidays - Prohibited unless authorized by a Permit |
| <p>Loading, unloading, delivering, collection, packing, unpacking, or otherwise handling any containers, construction equipment, products, materials or refuse whatsoever in a residential area</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any day between the hours of 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM |
| <p>Construction work inside a building with doors and windows installed and closed</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Any day - no restriction |

The Bylaw contains provisions for Exemption Permits. Pursuant to council Policy, these permits are only for use in urgent or emergency situations.
